Young Researchers' and Practitioners' Forum Topics

The Young Researchers' and Practitioners' Forum (YRPF) is a special format for young professionals. Early career researchers and practitioners are invited to present their work to the participants of the European Transport Conference. For the ETC 2024 early-stage and experimental projects and research ideas are explicitly welcome. The forum is intended to provide a format which enables constructive and comprehensive feedback as well as more time for discussion than usual. This year the YRPF sessions will focus on the ETC2024 topics:

- Human wellbeing
- Sustainable travel
- Mode-specific and inter-modal developments
- Labour, resource and energy challenges
- Regulatory issues
- Funding and financial sustainability
- Cities and transport
- Transport planning analysis and models
- Air travel and airports
- Technology and Artificial Intelligence

The Forum also administers the Neil Mansfield Award to the best paper presented at the YRPF sessions by an author aged 35 or under.

Important notice

If you submit an abstract, this will go through a selection process. Each year we receive more abstracts than can be accommodated in the programme. If your abstract is selected, please be aware that others have been rejected, that the ETC organisation has invested time in devising an attractive and coherent programme and that delegates have used this programme to decide to come to the conference.

Before submitting your abstract, please make sure there is time and funding to have at least one of the authors attending the conference to present the paper and that you have/will obtain the approval needed (from management or client) to present the work in public at the time of the conference. The conference organisers will require your commitment by the time of the abstract's acceptance.
