Submitting an Abstract for ETC 2026

Who can submit an abstract? We actively encourage people from all levels of expertise and experience within the transport profession to submit an abstract to present their work at the conference. Please be aware that by submitting an abstract, you commit yourself to being able to present your work in-person at the conference, to pay the fee for conference participation and to organise your own travel and accommodation.

How to submit an abstract? Abstracts can be submitted via our website. The submission portal opens early January 2026. More information on the abstract submission criteria and guidance for preparing your abstract is available on our website.

When will I be informed of acceptance or rejection? You will be informed in May 2026 if your abstract has been selected for inclusion in the conference programme. Please note that we receive more abstracts than we can accommodate in the final programme, so selection is not guaranteed.

If selected, what do I need to do? If selected, you can start preparing for the conference. You will receive further guidelines for presenting at our conference and information on writing a conference paper.

Paper repository: The repository of ETC past papers is a valuable resource of the Association for European Transport and is an important source of information for transport planners, researchers and engineers worldwide. We strongly encourage all speakers to submit a full paper, to be added to the repository, in addition to presenting their work at the conference.

Porto is an affordable destination, with hotel prices substantially lower than in other major European cities and plenty of places to enjoy good food at reasonable prices.


Accessible

Conference Language: The language of the conference is English and all presentations must be made in English.

Delegate Fees: Everyone who attends the Conference pays the appropriate fee for one, two or three days; this includes speakers and Programme Committee members.
