EUROPEAN TRANSPORT CONFERENCE 2024:

PROVIDING MOBILITY AND ACCESS FOR CURRENT AND FUTURE GENERATIONS

The climate emergency, increasing attention to equity issues, and a changing economic reality, continue to present challenges for transport planners. The increasingly intense debate among the public, and within governments, calls for a reliable evidence base to keep the focus on good solutions for current and future generations.

It is the transport planner's task to provide movement and access solutions for people and goods to get to where they need to be, in a sustainable, inclusive, efficient, and affordable manner. Achieving and maintaining stakeholder support is essential for this.

The transportation profession benefits from a diverse array of expertise from research policy and practice to achieve our mission. Let's come together at the 52nd European Transport Conference in 2024 to explore new developments, understand the challenges they pose, engage in new discussions, and formulate policy, service and infrastructure interventions.



ETC 2024 THEMES

This year's sessions will address relevant themes for the transport policy agenda throughout Europe and worldwide – from a research, policy or practice angle.

- **Human wellbeing** – healthy, efficient, safe and inclusive transport schemes for current and future generations
- **Sustainable travel** – shaping daily travel and long-distance trips in the face of climate change and energy transition
- **Mode-specific and inter-modal aspects** – local bus, tram and train, taxis, micro-mobility and active travel, private car with long-distance rail and bus, Mobility as a Service, integrated logistics, last-mile delivery and Enterprise Resource Planning
- **Labour, resource and energy challenges**
– supply constraints in freight and passenger transport
- **Regulatory issues** – impacts of international, national and local legislation and regulations on infrastructure and services
- **Funding and financial sustainability**
– private finance alongside public funding in collaborative delivery
- **Cities and transport** – integrated planning, active travel, liveable cities
- **Transport planning analysis and models**
– the methods and the tools for this century
- **Air travel and airports** – moving towards a more environmentally sustainable and commercially viable future
- **Technology and Artificial Intelligence**
– how can and will these shape transport in the future?

ABOUT THE CONFERENCE

The conference attracts transport policy makers, practitioners and researchers from all over Europe and beyond. At ETC, they can find in-depth presentations on policy issues, best practice and research findings across the broad spectrum of transport.

The range of topics with the multi-seminar approach makes ETC unique among transport conferences and it has established itself as the premier event of its type.

The conference programme encompasses local policy, national and international issues and the planning and execution of projects.

Discussing matters of policy at the highest level, delegates will find the sessions both engaging and inspiring.

In some cases basic education and training opportunities are presented, it is truly a conference incorporating all levels of experience.

How is the ETC programme developed?

The conference takes an open, participative approach to the development of its programme. AET Members can join a Programme Committee where they participate in the selection of abstracts to shape the contents of the conference.

The programme committees also propose broad themes for the upcoming conference to ensure ETC stays topical and focussed on the crucial transport issues of the day.

CONFERENCE FORMAT

The conference will be held over three days from Wednesday 18 to Friday 20 September 2024. Networking opportunities and technical visits will be available throughout, with optional social events offered during the evenings.

Stimulating Sessions

A key aspect of the conference is its scope, which covers the whole range of policy implications of research as well as technical details on data analyses or the design and operation of a model. Its reputation has been built on the important collaboration and knowledge transfer between policy, research and practice.

There will be a mix of plenary sessions, some debates and parallel workshop sessions. Each day, there will be a minimum of 9 parallel seminars in sessions of 1.5 or 2 hours, which include three to four papers presented in a themed session. The chair of each session ensures that there is time for questions and discussion of papers. Registered delegates may move freely between seminars.

Special features

- Plenary sessions on key topics, with keynote speeches given by prominent individuals in world transport
- Presentation of over 240 papers
- Pre-conference drinks reception on Tuesday 17 Sept.
- Civic Reception on Wednesday 18 Sept.
- Conference Dinner on Thursday 19 Sept.
- Networking with international colleagues

The conference provides a unique opportunity for all participants to engage with wide-ranging transport specialists from around the world and become part of an expert community. During the conference, a dedicated app will also provide a platform to connect with fellow delegates and arrange meetings.

Conference language

The language of the conference is English and all presentations will be made in English.
