Use of cookies

When you use this website, we may collect information about your computer, such as your IP address and/or browser, operating system, etc., which we will use for administration purposes, site improvement and statistical analysis. This information will not usually identify you personally.

We may also obtain information about your use of the site. We do this by placing a 'cookie', which is a small file, on your computer's hard disk. Cookies are used for several reasons:

- to recognise you when you visit this site
- to speed up and secure access to this site through a session
- to store your personal preferences while visiting the site
- to improve the quality of your experience by analysing general site usage.

The cookies that are set by this website include:

PHPSESSID	PHP Session ID. This is a unique identifier that is automatically created when a Session starts for a given visitor.	This cookie is deleted when browser is closed.
_utma	Google Analytics randomly generated number.	2 years
_utmb	We use Google Analytics to monitor traffic levels, search queries and visits to this website.	30 minutes
_utmc	Google Analytics stores IP address anonymously on its servers, and neither Tribal or Google associate your IP address with any personally identifiable information.	This cookie is deleted when browser is closed.

COOKIE_LAST_EXTRANET_EMAIL	CMS Extranet opt-in cookie. This is set if you choose to ask this website to remember your login name.	Until you opt-out via the login screen
LOG_ME_IN_COOKIE	CMS Extranet opt-in cookie. This is set if you choose to ask your computer to automatically log you in at this computer	Until you opt-out via the login screen
zenario_storefront_basket_id	CMS e-commerce cookie. This is set when you put an item in your basket.	1 month
